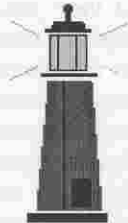
GRAND CHAPTER CHECKLIST

Voting Credentials

All Chapters must register credentials. The Worthy Matron, Worthy Patron, Associate Matron, and Associate Patron are the representatives of each Chapter. If these officers are not able to attend, it is important for them to sign the bottom of their credential, giving another member of their chapter the proxy. Be sure all four of your Chapter's Credentials are registered, as there is important business to come before the Grand Chapter this year. Credential Registration is from 9:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday and from 8:00 am to 12 noon on Wednesday.

If you will not be going to Pershing Center to pick up your tickets before your banquet, they can be delivered to the banquet if you will write your request on the pre-registration form.
