Important Information about Student Loans---

The new Educational Loan Committee wishes to announce that the deadline date for submitting applications for educational loans has been moved up to April 30th. New and former applicants must submit applications, letter of recommendation and transcripts to the Grand Chapter office by that date. Students who are members or relatives members of the Order of the Eastern Star are eligible for these loans. The maximum which can be loaned per semester is \$2,200. The loans are for a period of four years and the interest rate (which must be paid annually) is 4%. With the interest on a Stafford loan (government loan) now at 6.8% members should encourage qualifying students to appy for the Eastern Star Student Loan. \$346,683.05 was reported raised for Heart in the last triennium. \$276,480.65 was raised for Shriners'

Total contributed to ESTARL through the G.G.C. in the last triennium was \$1,535,774.16. \$250,096.43 was given through GGC for Hurricane Katrina victims.

All of us in Nebraska are so proud of those who have been appointed to serve in the General Grand Chapter in the coming Triennium. I am looking forward to hearing from all of the General Grand Chapter Committees and sharing their plans with our Nebraska members.
