Here are some important reminders concerning the upcoming Session:

- 1) **Deadline for pre-registration is April 25**—also, to guarantee that you get our special rate, make your hotel reservations by April 15th.
- 2) Remember, **if you have been appointed as a Grand Page, Assistant Grand Warden or Assistant Grand Sentinel** you will receive a complementary ticket to the Pages, Warders and Sentinels banquet on Monday evening—if you plan to attend be sure you make a reservation as instructed on the pre-registration form—you need a reservation even though your ticket is comp.
- 3) Call Dot Mattern 402-455-0272 if you are planning to attend the **Grand Duck Luncheon**.
- 4) **If you are a PAGO**, remember that PAGOS furnish cookies for the Distinguished Guest Room at the hotel—bring your cookies to that room Tuesday morning. Call Carolyn Plants (402-477-9464) if you can help in that room on Tuesday.
- 5) **If you are a present or past Grand Representative**, if you can donate cookies bring them to the hospitality room.
- 6) **Don't forget:**

~ **your gold credential** (if you are one of the top four officers of your Chapter or carrying the proxy for one of those officers).

The quotations used in this article are from Jim Rohn a noted motivational speaker and author.

“Effective communication uses brevity--- Jesus said ‘Follow me’. Now that’s brief, he could be brief because of all that he was, that he didn’t have to say.”

“You cannot speak that which you do not know. You cannot share that which you do not feel. You cannot translate that which you do not have. And you cannot give that which you do not possess. To give it and to save it and for it to be effective, you first need to have it.” **Good communication starts with good preparation.**

Smaller communities have an advantage over larger communities in that they have closer ties with one another, know one another, trust one another, and can be sold on joining Masonry and the Order of the Eastern Star and other Masonic family organizations.

“Effective communication should be for listeners to say ‘me too!’ versus ‘so what?’ Effective communication is 20% of what you know and 80% how you feel about what you know.”

Remember in the membership article that we talked about two words - “Just Ask!” but we also need to be prepared to answer questions about the Order of the Eastern Star utilizing 20% of what you know. Emphasize how you feel about what you know about our beautiful order.

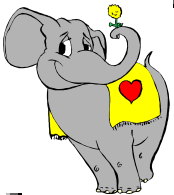
