2021 Ritual Instructions

Let us make sure we are certain and secure with these simple fundamentals.

OPENING:

WP, AP, AC and Organist enter together

AP, AC, Organist are seated together without a rap of the gavel

WP use of the gavel:

One Rap when reaching the podium.

This rap is to call the room to order before addressing the Chapter

WM use of the gavel:

REMEMBER: The ritual's use of the direction:

"Worthy Matron seats the chapter" is a directive to use the gavel.

One rap to seat Chapter when she instructs officers to take their stations Sit (without rap) with officers when officers reach their stations

#17 page 15 BOI - Opening

Two raps to call up officers at the completion of Proving Chapter Three raps when directing Conductress to attend the Altar One light rap on the word "business" when speaks the Chapter is open One rap to seat chapter at the completion of the Flag Salute

WM uses a light rap of the gavel for declaration of completion of an order of business, each order of business.

Square corners are observed by Conductress for escort of WM

REMEMBER: Square corners are understood to be used at all times unless specific direction is given in the Ritual.

Altar Ceremony:

Instruct and encourage the Conductress and Chaplain Altar Service Movements and wording as provided:

Step back from Altar

Eyes on Bible in reverence

Conductress turns right, proceeds forward to position in circle.

Conductress turns right to stand. (Toward Esther)

Chaplain turns **left**, proceeds forward to position in circle.

Chaplain turns **left** to stand. (Toward Esther)

Signs and Passes:

Encourage the Worthy Patron:

Choose one meeting during the year where he reviews the Secret Work wording and together the Chapter reviews signs and passes.

When in person, Supervisor will demonstrate and chapter may practice together.

· CLOSING:

WM: Ask for Words for the Good of the Order

ALWAYS - each meeting

Give time for members to respond, then ask again following each members' remarks

Ritual of the Closing begins with the WM's address of the AM.

If there is further business to be addressed, the ritual ceremony ceases.

The business is addressed.

The WM again starts the ritual Closing Ceremony again beginning with her address of the AM.

WM use of gavel:

Calls up Chapter with three raps to sing the Closing Ode

Warder's address to Sentinel that Chapter is closed marks the completion of ritualistic Closing Ceremony.

No response is given to the WM by the Warder. No use of the gavel. (Item #1 Page 69, BOI) WM sits with all present. No use of the gavel.

Opening and Closing Odes:

Both the Opening and Closing Odes are ritualistic.

They must be included in the ceremonies.

They made be sung with accompaniment, a cappella, or spoken.

Selection of the Ode is the prerogative of the WM.

Odes can vary from one meeting to another.

· Open Installation:

WP enters alone and gives one rap of the gavel to call the Chapter to Order. Officers enter without direction. **Ritual page 97**

(BOI: Open Installation; Item #5 Page 76.) If there is no Stated Meeting prior to Installation, the Worthy Patron calls the meeting to order by giving one rap of the gavel and the retiring officers march in and assume their stations without invitation or escort. If it is the desire of the Chapter that this incoming informal march be made to music, the Organist would be seated at the instrument prior to entrance of the Worthy Patron entering.)

Regular form to open a Special Meeting (i.e. Open Installation)

- WM directs Conductress to open the Bible and calls up the Chapter.
- Conductress opens the Bible and returns to her station.
- As directed by WM, Lord's Prayer is prayed in unison.
- WM strikes one rap of the gavel and declares the Chapter open for the special meeting. States the purpose of the special meeting (i.e. for the Ceremony of Installation of Officers)
- WM directs the Pledge of Allegiance and the singing of the National Anthem.
- WM seats the Chapter.
- WM welcomes and recognizes distinguished guests. **RITUAL PAGE 97**This grants the opportunity for recognition of guests from the side lines.
